

GDPR information clause

1. Providing of your personal data is voluntary, however in the event of failure to do so, you will not be able to take part in the Futures of Food: The hottest tech for resilient agriculture and circular food system (the “Event”).
2. Your data included in the application form will be processed by the Joint Controllers pursuant to:
 - a) art. 6 sec. 1 (b) of the general regulation on the protection of personal data of April 27, 2016 ("GDPR") in connection with the implementation of the contract for participation in the Event, in accordance with the details deriving from the implementation of the EIT Food Accelerator Network programme (Food Accelerator Network - EIT Food - EIT Food), what includes: provide full service, including solving technical and organizational problems, contacting you in connection with registration to the Event, defense against possible claims, statistical purposes, as well as for the purpose of reporting the Event under the European Union's Horizon Europe Framework Program, including documenting and disseminating the Event, and therefore, for this purpose, the image of participants of the Event may be processed and disseminated, where appropriate;
 - b) art. 6 sec. 1 (a) of the GDPR within the scope of innovation promotion, where each of the Joint Controllers acts as a sole controller of personal data.
3. Your personal data may be shared with:
 - a. other co-organizers of the Event in order to conduct the Event,
 - b. other entities, persons or bodies that will process personal data as their independent controller - to the extent and on the terms set out in the law and the European Union's Horizon Europe Framework Program (e.g. EIT Food iVZW, entities authorized to conduct inspections and audits projects under the Horizon Europe Program - the European Institute of Innovation and Technology, the European Commission, the European Anti-Fraud Office (“OLAF”), the European Court of Auditors),
 - c. persons authorized by the Joint Controllers, their employees and associates who must have access to data to perform their duties,
 - d. processors to whom the Joint Controllers entrust this task, e.g. those operating ICT systems, the advisors, related entities to the extent that they carry out data processing processes on behalf of the Joint Controllers, entities providing photo/video services.
4. The Joint Controllers of your personal data in connection with the registration of participation in the Event are: EIT Food CLC North-East sp. z o.o., 00-675 Warsaw, ul. Sending a request to a given Joint Controller obliges him to respond.
5. Your personal data will be stored for 5 years, due to the European Union's Horizon Europe Framework Program.

6. The Joint Controllers do not intend to transfer your contact data to a third country or international organization, unless it is needed to use special tools that meet criteria of the GDPR.
7. Your personal data is subject of profiling regarding your location.
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint, when you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR, to the President of the Office for Data Protection (or the supervisory authority dealing with the protection of personal data in another country, in particular in the Member State of your habitual residence, place of work or place committing the alleged infringement).
